Spotlight on...

Air Explorers Now at Whiteman Airport

Low cost flight training is now making it possible for many young men and women to learn how to fly at Whiteman Airport. Air Explorers Squadron 3, a non-profit organization started at Whiteman Airport in 1951 and sponsored by the Optimist Club of North Hollywood, recently moved their Cessna 172 back to Whiteman Airport from Van Nuys Airport.

The Air Explorer program provides flight training to men and women ages 14 to 21. The program depends primarily on donations to cover the high costs of insuring, operating, and maintaining their aircraft. Student pilots pay only \$65.00 per hour for a wet airplane and a volunteer certified flight instructor. And, the instructors are unquestionably top of the line

Ralph Truglio is the chief pilot and has taught many young and older men and women how to fly since he joined the Optimist Club in 1955. In fact, Ralph taught Don Hagopian, President of the Whiteman Airport Association, to fly at Whiteman Airport back in 1965. Don played an instrumental role in bringing the Air Explorer's airplane to Whiteman Airport. Keith Burton, a retired airline pilot and long-time tenant at Whiteman Airport, also volunteers his time to provide flight instruction for the program.

Since its move to Whiteman Airport, the Air Explorers have picked up numerous new student pilots, including one of American Airports' employees, and logged over 87 hours of flight instruction time in its first six weeks at the Airport. While rent and fuel are discounted by American Airports for the Air Explorers, contributions are still very much needed and greatly appreciated.
