Spotlight on...

Flying Masterpiece at Whiteman Airport

Whiteman Airport tenant, Craig Schultze, brought home the "gold" from the recent 2008 EAA (Experimental Aviation Association) AirVenture Oshkosh. Among the nearly 2,500 aircraft (homebuilt, antique, classic, warbird, ultralight, and rotorcraft) at the event, Craig's Lancair 320 was awarded the very coveted "Gold Lindy Grand Champion" (Gold Lindy) in the kit built category – classifying the aircraft as a true flying masterpiece.

Craig has been a tenant at Whiteman Airport for nearly 13 years. Early on, Craig owned and operated a Piper Cherokee 140 and later a Piper Comanche but caught the bug to build his own aircraft after watching his friends build and fly their fast and attractive Lancairs. With the help of his young sons and the advice and inspiration from his friends at Whiteman Airport, it took Craig only 20 months to build his Lancair 320, mostly constructed in his garage at home.

Some of the criteria used in awarding the Gold Lindy are workmanship, fit and finish, quality, safety and airworthiness, and the spirit of the aviator/builder of the experimental aircraft. Craig's Lancair is powered by a Lycoming 320 with 10:1 pistons and a Superior cold air induction sump. It has a top speed at sea level of 216 knots. The cruise speed at 7,500 feet msl is 207 knots, burning 8.5 gallons per hour.

In addition to the recent Gold Lindy, the aircraft was awarded the Bronze Lindy at the 2007 EAA AirVenture Oshkosh and the Grand Champion award at the last show at Agua Dulce Airport. For this year's Oshkosh event, Craig added some cowl modifications that helped to increase the speed by streamlining the air coming in to cool the engine.

Way to go, Craig. Congratulations!
