Spotlight on...

NFL Star Reggie Bush Takes a Ride

Reggie Bush, a star running back for the New Orleans Saints and 2005 Heisman Trophy winner, took a ride he will never forget over his San Diego home town on Saturday in a Red Bull Air Race World Championship two-seater. Bush has faced a lot of intimidating defenses on the football field and taken some pretty hard hits. But nothing prepared him for the 7g turns in midair over San Diego.

"I thought I was going to die," Bush said after a high-speed, high-g ride with pilot Sergio Pla. "It's the ultimate, most scary ride ever invented. Ever. There's nothing scarier than flying upside down, spiraling down. Your life flashes by in front of your eyes. I wasn't expecting anything like that. It was just awesome. It was really great."

Bush candidly admitted he spent quite a bit of his time aloft screaming as the ground and horizon spun endlessly past him. "We started out just making right-hand turns and I thought 'this is easy'. Then he turns straight up into the air and then starts spiraling down. The spiraling down part was scary. So was the flying upside stuff. Actually, the whole thing was scary. When we were upside I felt like there was nothing covering me. I felt like I could just fall out of the seat. It was just very, very scary. Sergio has a bit of a foreign accent and every time he'd say something I would ask 'What?' just as he would pull into some crazy manouever. He was doing all the talking. I was doing more velling and screaming."

Pla told Bush he had nothing to worry about. "He looked a little scared but I told him this was nothing compared to football players weighing over 300 pounds trying to tackle him. That is scarv."

American pilot Mike Mangold said he was duly impressed by Bush's stamina in absorbing the 7g ride in the plane that has an empty weight of just over 1,000 pounds – engine and all. "He thought the forces were pretty awesome," said Mangold, a Californian who won the world championship in 2005 and 2007. "It's definitely a different experience than getting tackled in football. He was worried about the engine and I don't blame him. He relies on his legs; we rely on our engines. He didn't get sick, though. He did 7gs and that's great for a first timer."
