Airport Improvements

The recent Stakeholder Meeting held on September 24th was another productive meeting. As a result of comments and discussion from that meeting, American Airports has worked with one of the third-party hangar tenants to enhance lighting on hangar buildings in the northern portion of the Airport which has improved the overall apron and taxi lane lighting in and around the area. Enhanced lighting is also being installed near the public areas just outside of the Administration Building and Restaurant. Additionally, American Airports is in the process of setting up a County hangar to be made available for non-commercial aircraft maintenance on a daily or weekly basis. SPOTLIGHT ON...

Supporting the US Forest Service Effort To Fight The Station Fire

In September, four of our LA County airports, supplied fuel and services to the firefighting efforts for the massive arson-caused Station Fire that burned more than 250 square miles of the Angeles National Forest. The fire, which began on August 26th, scorched over 160,000 acres, making it the largest fire in recorded Los Angeles County history and the 10th largest in California since 1933.

Brackett Airport – The US Forest Service utilized Brackett for their Heli-base. The close work between Airport Operations and the Forestry Service allowed a safe and efficient operation while ensuring a strong aerial defense. At the peak, Brackett was home to 8 Sky-cranes, an AH-1 Cobra and one Kaman K-Max helicopter. Using Brackett as a base allowed a quick response and more frequent water drops that proved to be imperative.

Whiteman Airport - The US Forest Service was using Whiteman as a base of operations for 12 days. Fire crews utilized the ramp/apron areas for helicopter parking (1-3) helicopters and used the public viewing grassy area as a staging site throughout their stay. As the fire moved to the east, the USFS moved from Whiteman to El Monte.

El Monte Airport - Flight crews operating Bell 207 & A-Star helicopters utilized El Monte for a couple of days as a base to battle on the frontlines during the height of the fire storm. In addition to providing a place for firefighting aircraft to operate from, El Monte made its facilities available for crews to shower, eat, and take a break from the frontlines.

Fox Airfield - Anywhere from 2 to 23 fixed-wing aircraft, multiple helicopters, plus lead and support aircraft flew in and out of the Fox Field to fight the fire, daily. Each helicopter was supported by two or three semi-trailer trucks. Airport staff worked from dawn to dusk fueling aircraft, while neighboring airport businesses supplied food for the crews flying in and out every day.

We are proud of the role and significant contribution our County Airports made during the Station Fire.
