Spotlight on... Construction & Development

Whiteman Airport

A new airport access road being constructed at Whiteman Airport is expected to be completed month, weather permitting. The new road will eventually provide for a safer vehicle traffic flow on the airport. Elsewhere on the airport, construction for a new hangar complex begins this month. The complex, being built by Argubright Construction, will consist of nine commercial-sized hangars and up to three commercial buildings. Vista Aviation will start construction of their new hangar complex and world class repair facility in the first quarter of this year. Vista will build about 39 nested T-hangars and a few large box hangars. By the end of this year, Whiteman Airport expects to have enough aircraft hangar capacity to meet demand. Fox Airfield

A project to build new hangars at Fox Airfield is on schedule to begin this Spring. The highly anticipated project will increase hangar capacity by about 30 hangars, bringing the total up to just under 100 hangars on the field. Contact information will also be available from the Airport Manager at 661-940-1709. Details on rental price are not yet known. However, the hangars will be rectangular, not T-shape. The sizes will be 42'x35', 40'x 50' and 50'x60'.
