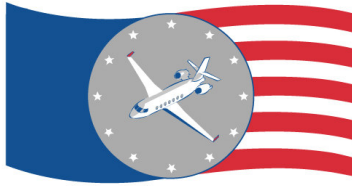

## **Spotlight on...**

### **Aircraft Liability Insurance**

It is a common aviation industry practice for airport operators to require owners of based aircraft to maintain and provide proof of certain limits of aircraft liability insurance. Similar to automobile liability insurance requirements, this means you can feel sure of adequate protection in the event you sustain personal injury or property damage while on the airport through the fault of another aviation tenant. It is also common for airport operators to require that they, the airport operator, be named as an Additional Insured on these insurance policies. Additional Insured endorsements serve to provide extra coverage against the airport operator's risk of vicarious liability arising through accidents caused by a based aircraft owner, and reinforce indemnity clauses in hangar and tie-down license agreements.

In keeping with industry standards, it is our policy to require owners of based aircraft to provide proof of aircraft liability insurance in the types and amounts as outlined in their license agreements. We also require you to include American Airports Corporation and the County of Los Angeles on your policy as Additional Insureds. Most insurance companies can easily include the Additional Insured endorsement upon your request, and this will not typically increase your premiums. Once AAC and LA County are named Additional Insureds, your insurance company will take responsibility for providing your proof of insurance directly to us. Ask your insurance provider to send proof of insurance to our corporate offices: American Airports Corp., ATTN: Operations, 2425 Olympic Blvd., Suite 650E, Santa Monica, CA 90404.

We realize that different insurance companies offer slightly different insurance products and endorsement definitions. If you or your provider have any questions regarding your insurance, contact the Airport Administration office.
