

PROJECT AT A GLANCE

Aircraft Parking Ramp Project

The project will refurbish 252,000 square feet of existing aircraft parking ramp pavement (mid-field area of the airport) and develop 1.2 acres of previously unimproved land to provide 70 additional tie-down spaces.

Project Overview

- Project Start Date: February 13, 2012
- Project Completion Date (estimate): June 30, 2012
- Access to the airport will not be disrupted. Construction equipment and material will be delivered to the airport through the service access gate along Pierce Avenue (adjacent to the run-up area for Runway 12)
- The wash-rack facility will be closed intermittently during construction
- Low-profile barricades will be placed around the project site
- During construction, a portion of Taxiway Alpha will be closed with low-profile barricades adjacent to the project site, including Taxiway exit Bravo

Project Tasks

- Removal of existing power lines and poles
- Removal of concrete and asphalt material
- Overexcavation and recompaction of subgrade material
- Construction of plant mix bituminous surface course (asphalt concrete)
- Install tie-down anchors and chains
- Conduct electrical work including installation of new apron floodlights
- Apply pavement markings
- Apply refined coal tar (fuel-resistant) slurry seal coat
