Contract Tower Funding Update. We received some encouraging news when the staff draft of the Fiscal Year 2014 DOT/FAA Appropriations the Senate from Transportation Appropriations Subcommittee included \$140 million in dedicated funding for the Contract Tower Program. This represents the funding levels needed to keep our tower and all other contract towers open through fiscal year 2014 which begins October 1, 2013 and runs through September 30, 2014. Organizations like the AAAE and USCTA are pushing for additional specificity in the bill highlight congressional support for the contract tower program and the expectation from lawmakers that the program remain operational and not subject to targeting for disproportionate cuts from the Administration to deal with sequestration.

This is certainly a good sign and a good first step but I

recommend that anyone who feels strongly about the Tower remaining open continue to make their voice heard though their elected representatives.
