NEW VEHICLE ACCESS GATE UPDATE. Both our main vehicle access gate located next to the Administration Office and the access gate located on Airpark Way next to the D Row hangars are now operational. For those that have not come to our office to obtain a new gate card please do so during our office hours, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. Monday through Friday. A new type of gate card is needed to access the gates and with the upgrades now being performed on our third gate at Orbital Way, the old gate cards will no longer work at the Airport.

New coded entry locks were also installed at the pedestrian gates located in the park area in front of the Administration Office. The code for these gates is the first three digits of the ground frequency here at WHP, or 1 2 5.

Spotlight on: Airport Rules and Regulations Los Angeles County Code - Title 19

All five LA County Airports are required to follow specific rules and regulations put forth by the County of Los Angeles. These rules and regulations are outlined in LA County Code Title 19.

The purpose of the code is to make sure that all airports are following minimum standards to safeguard life, limb, property and public welfare by regulating and controlling the various activities on airports owned or operated or both by the County of Los Angeles. These provisions are applicable to any person, firm or corporation using the airport. Anyone found in violation of any Title 19 codes can be found guilty of a misdemeanor and can be fined and/or imprisoned.

Title 19 covers six (6) areas of the airports. 1) General Provisions, 2) Definitions, 3) Rules and Regulations, 4) Aircraft Operations and Facilities, 5) Motor Vehicle Regulations, and 6) Fire Regulations.

Now that summer is in full swing, the weather has been perfect for flying and many of you have been pulling out your aircraft and getting them ready to fly. As ready your aircraft to take to the air, we would like to make you aware of the rules and regulations regarding maintenance and repair activities.

19.04.850 Aircraft-Maintenance and repair activities

- A. Aircraft may be maintained and repaired on county -owned airports in designated maintenance and repair areas and buildings, in leased areas and buildings , in tee hangars and tiedown spaces rented under aircraft storage license agreements, and in buildings or areas approved or assigned by the airport manager, subject to compliance with terms and conditions included in applicable leases or license agreements.
- B. Aircraft maintenance and repair performed in the areas and buildings is authorized subject to compliance with appropriate Federal Aviation Regulations, government agencies and provided in Section 19.04.050 of this chapter, Building and Fire Codes, and airport regulations. Maintenance performed by commercial operators not otherwise authorized by lease license agreement or contract is permitted subject to compliance with Sections 19.04.520 and 19.04.580 of this chapter.

The airports provide you with amenities to help you maintain your aircraft such as washracks and oil bins for used oil, and separate bins for oil waste such as filters and rags. If you are doing your own maintenance please make sure that your are disposing of your waste properly, and if in doubt, ask one of the Operations Staff and they will help you properly dispose of your waste.
