From the Manager

Saturday, March 24th, was a busy day here at WHP as the Aviation Explorer Post 747, The San Fernando Valley 99's and EAA Chapter 40 all held events in front of the Admin Building. Aviation Explorer Post 747 held their annual Pancake Breakfast fundraiser while the 99's sold aviation memorabilia and the EAA held their monthly Young Eagles event. Airport tenants and members from our surrounding community were in attendance and often the crowd was so large it spilled off the grassy area in front of the Admin Building! <u>Tie Down Project Update.</u> Our new tie rows have been paved and the tie down anchors have been installed. The remaining work still to be completed includes a slurry seal, tie down chain installation, paint striping and electrical work including the installation of apron lighting. Taxiway Alpha will remain closed until new taxiway striping can be placed down so please remember to use caution as all aircraft transitioning the airport north to south (or vice versa) are still using the back taxi lane area. As always anyone with any questions or comments regarding the project is encouraged to contact my office at (818) 896-5271 and thank you for your cooperation.

<u>Slurry Project Coming Soon.</u> While definitive dates have yet to be set for the Slurry Seal project which will commence following the completion of the Tie Down project we do anticipate a starting date in June. Tie rows 31 and 32 will be affected and airplanes on those rows will need to be relocated to unaffected tie downs so that the slurry may be laid down. A letter to all those with aircraft in the affected areas will go out once a final determination on starting dates has been set.

<u>Looking For a New or Different Hangar?</u> If you currently lease a tie down or if you're in a hangar and would like to move to a different hangar please stop by the Administration Office, Monday through Friday between the hours of 8 am and 5 pm, to discuss the hangar space that is currently available. If the particular hangar of your choice is not available now, we will provide you with a hangar waitlist application to fill out so that we can move you in to the hangar of your choice as soon as possible!

<u>Hangar Repairs?</u> If you are having difficulty with your hangar please to not hesitate to call my office at (818) 896-5271 so that we may diagnose the problem and make the appropriate fixes.

International Learn to Fly Day May 19

EAA's third annual International Learn to Fly Day will be held Saturday, May 19.

Local EAA chapters are leading the way for this aviation community-wide effort, according to EAA officials. Chapters will offer adult orientation flights, which are similar to EAA's Young Eagles program, which has offered free flights to more than 1.6 million kids ages 8-17 since 1992.

Last year's event also served as an opportunity for chapter members to try out the Eagle Flights concept, a program similar to Young Eagles for adults. With the first Eagle Flight scheduled to take place at AirVenture 2012, initial response to the concept has been overwhelming from members, EAA officials said.

"The joy, fulfillment, and sense of accomplishment of flying an aircraft is unlike anything else one can experience," said Rod Hightower, EAA president/CEO. "As we grow the next generation of aviators, International Learn to Fly Day is one day where we can make a special effort to invite and welcome those who have always dreamed of flying."

EAA encourages other aviation organizations and businesses to join the effort by offering introductory flights, seminars, and open houses at airports and other locations throughout the United States and the world.
