Los Angeles County Aviation Division Honored by SWAAE

We wanted to spread the news to all our customers that LA County Aviation Commissioner, Curt Castagna and Aviation Division Chief, Richard Smith were recently honored by the American Association of Airport Executives' Southwest Chapter (SWAAAE).

At the SWAAAE Summer Conference in Sacramento this past July, Mr. Smith was awarded "Airport Executive of the Year." SWAAAE represents airports primarily in California, Arizona, Nevada, and Hawaii and to have earned this recognition is truly a remarkable accomplishment!

Criteria to be nominated for the Airport Executive of the Year includes providing public service to the community in the form of efficient air transportation facilities; public relation accomplishments in the areas of "good neighbor relations"; environmental achievements in the areas of aesthetics, noise or pollution reduction or control; good business management in budget control, utilization of airport revenue, development of new sources of revenue and control of expenses; efficient handling of the administrative complexities of state and federal grant programs; management functions and good labor relations with employees and tenants; personal integrity and professional reputation, both in the public community and among peers in the airport management field.



SWAAAE also recognized Commissioner Curt Castagna with the "Corporate Award of Excellence" for his long history of taking leadership roles in airport tenant, aviation trade associations and establishing collaborative partnerships through complex industry challenges, while maintaining a focus on compromise and consensus building. Most importantly, Commissioner Curt Castagna has long been devoted to mentoring future aviation professionals, in and out of the classroom, with over 23 years' experience, as an adjunct professor, teaching various classes in the Aviation Administration Bachelor of Arts Program at California State University, Los Angeles.

The Corporate Award of Excellence is presented to a company whose professionalism and recent contributions to the association and the airport industry have made a significant difference in fostering aviation. Members of SWAAAE nominate candidates from all over the Southwestern states for this single award given only once per year. Amazing!
