Welcome to the Chief

Richard Smith was recently appointed Chief, Aviation Division for Los Angeles County, Department of Public Works. He has been an active pilot for ten years and is an aircraft owner based at El Monte Airport as well as a member of several professional aviation and airport organizations.

Richard earned a Bachelor of Business and Administration degree from the University of North Dakota, with an emphasis on Airport Management. He served four years active duty in the US Air Force as a Crew Chief on C-130E aircraft and currently serves as a Crew Chief on the new J Model C-130 aircraft with the California National Guard. He has accumulated a total of fifteen years of service.

Prior to his promotion to Division Chief at the County, Richard served as an Airport Project Coordinator. He served in this capacity for over two and a half years. Over that time period, he was responsible for managing capital improvement projects which helped maintain and improve the infrastructure of the County airports. In the past three years, Richard successfully obtained more than \$6 million in Federal and State grants, for the County.

Prior to joining the County, Richard served as an Airport Manager at El Monte Airport, Compton/Woodley Airport, and a small general aviation airport in Wisconsin.

"I am grateful for the opportunity to serve the tenants and users of the airports. Together, we face many challenges, and there is a lot of work to accomplish. I look forward to working with our tenants and business operators, our Aviation Commission, and airport management to continually improve the County airports."
