Farewell to the Chief

On September 26, 2007, during his retirement farewell at the Aviation Commission meeting at El Monte Airport, Ted A. Gustin, Chief, Aviation Division for Los Angeles County was formally recognized through a reading of a Los Angeles County Board of Supervisors scroll commending him for his more than thirty-eight years of outstanding, dedicated service to the County of Los Angeles.

Gustin began his career with the County of Los Angeles as an airport serviceman on May 4, 1969. He originally worked at the County Engineer, which then merged with the Flood Control District and Road Department in 1985 to become the Department of Public Works. He is known for his humility and often recited the story of how his first job at the airports was cleaning the bathrooms at Brackett Field.

On May 1, 1991, Gustin was promoted to Chief, Aviation Division for the Department of Public Works where he oversaw the five County regional airports. He is commended for his exemplary performance and participation on Public Works' Strategic Priority Area Committee and the Homeland Security Committee. He was also an active member of the Southern California Association of Governments Technical Advisory Committee and served on the Los Angeles County Aviation Commission as an administrator. He holds a professional credential of California Airport Executive issued by the Southwest Chapter of American Association of Airport Executives. Gustin is a pilot and a veteran of the United States Army.

Ted Gustin has been a pleasure to work with and will be tremendously missed. We extend sincere best wishes for a happy, healthy and rewarding retirement. Richard Smith, of Publics Works Aviation Division, will be Acting Chief until a permanent appointment is made.
